Ages & Stages Questionnaire - 3 (ASQ-3)®

What is ASQ -3?

ASQ-3 is a questionnaire that focuses on your child's development and provides a quick look at how your child is doing in important areas, such as communication, physical ability, social skills, and problem-solving skills.

Who Completes the ASQ-3?

ASQ-3 is completed by the caregiver. This will take 10-15 minutes. It's that quick and easy.

Here's How ASQ-3 Works:

Answer each question "yes," "sometimes," or "not yet" based on what your child is able to do now. Your answers help show your child's strengths and areas where your child may need practice.

To answer each question, you can try fun and simple activities with your child. These activities encourage your child to play, move around, and practice day-to-day skills.

After you complete the questionnaire, you will discuss the results with your child's professional. Together, you will determine next steps and what milestones to expect moving forward.

Ages & Stages Questionnaire: Social-Emotional - 2 (ASQ:SE - 2)®

What is ASQ: SE - 2?

ASQ:SE-2 is a questionnaire that can help identify your child's social-emotional strengths and areas where your child may need support. A child's social emotional development focuses on how a child starts to understand who they are, what they are feeling and what to expect when interacting with others.

Who Completes the ASQ:SE-2?

ASQ:SE-2 is completed by the caregiver. This will take 10-15 minutes. It's that quick and easy.

Here's How ASQ:SE-2 Works:

Answer each question by marking "often or always," "sometimes," or "rarely or never." Answer based on what you know about your child.

Please make comments if any behaviors concern you.

Remember that your answers help show your child's strengths and areas where your child may need support.

After you complete the questionnaire, you will discuss the results with your child's professional. Together, you will determine next steps and what milestones to expect moving forward.
