



Maine ECCP- Early Childhood Mental Health Consultation Program- Now Available

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The Maine Early Childhood Consultation Partnership (ECCP) is an infant and early childhood mental health consultation program now available to early childhood education providers and families in seven Maine counties. ECCP is an evidence-based, time-limited program designed to address the social-emotional needs of children ages 0-8 in early care and education programs. ECCP offers support, education, and consultation to early care and education providers and families of young children to support children's emotional wellbeing and effectively manage challenging behavior. Services are provided at no cost to early care and education classrooms or individual children enrolled in early care and education programs. Services may be requested by families, child care providers, early childhood educators, or program directors.

ECCP is currently being piloted in the following counties: Androscoggin, Aroostook, Cumberland, Hancock, Penobscot, Washington and York.
