## **Determination of Eligibility:**

Is at least 21 years old

Has a Related Condition:

- A. Cerebral Palsy or Epilepsy; or
- B. Any other condition, other than mental illness, found to be closely related to Intellectual Disabilities

It is manifested before the person reaches age twenty two (22)

It is likely to continue indefinitely

Results in substantial functional limitation in 3 or more of the following areas of major life activity:

- Self-care
- Understanding & use of language
- Learning
- Mobility
- Self-Direction
- Capacity for Independent living
