

Other Related Conditions Waiver Covered Services

Care Coordination	 Assist participants in gaining access to needed waiver and other State plan services, as well as medical, social, education and other services.
Home Support	Assists with the acquisition, retention, or improvement in skills related to living in the community.
Personal Care Services	Hands-on assistance or cuing to assist with daily living tasks.
Community Support Services	 Assistance with self-help, socialization and adaptive skills that takes place in a non-residental setting.
Assistive Technology	Device that increases, improves, maintains functional capabilities of the member including: Evaluation. Purchase/lease of device, Maintaining/Repairing device, Training, and Transmission.
Work Support and Employment Specialist Services	Ongoing support to obtain and maintain a job in competitive, customized, or self-employment.
Physical Therapy, Occupation Therapy, and Speech Therapy Services	Direct therapy and consultation services to maintain functioning and prevent regression, loss of movement, injury and medical complications.
Communication Aids	Devices or services necessary to assist with hearing, speech or vision impairments to effectively communicate.
Consultation and Assessment	Clinical and therapeutic services that assist caregivers in carrying out Care Plans including Psychological, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Speech Therapy, and Behavioral Health.
Non-Tradition Communication Assessment and Consultation	Assessment and consultation to assist the member to maximize communcation ability both expressively and receptively durign day-to-day activities
Specialized Medical Equipment	 Devices, controls, or appliances that enable members to increase their ability to perform activities of daily living, communicate, life support or physical conditions, durable and non-durable medical equipment, and medical supplies.
Home Accessibility Adaptations	 Physical adaptations of the private residence of a member or the member's family that are necessary to ensure the health, welfare and safety of the member or that enable the member to function with greater independence in the home.
