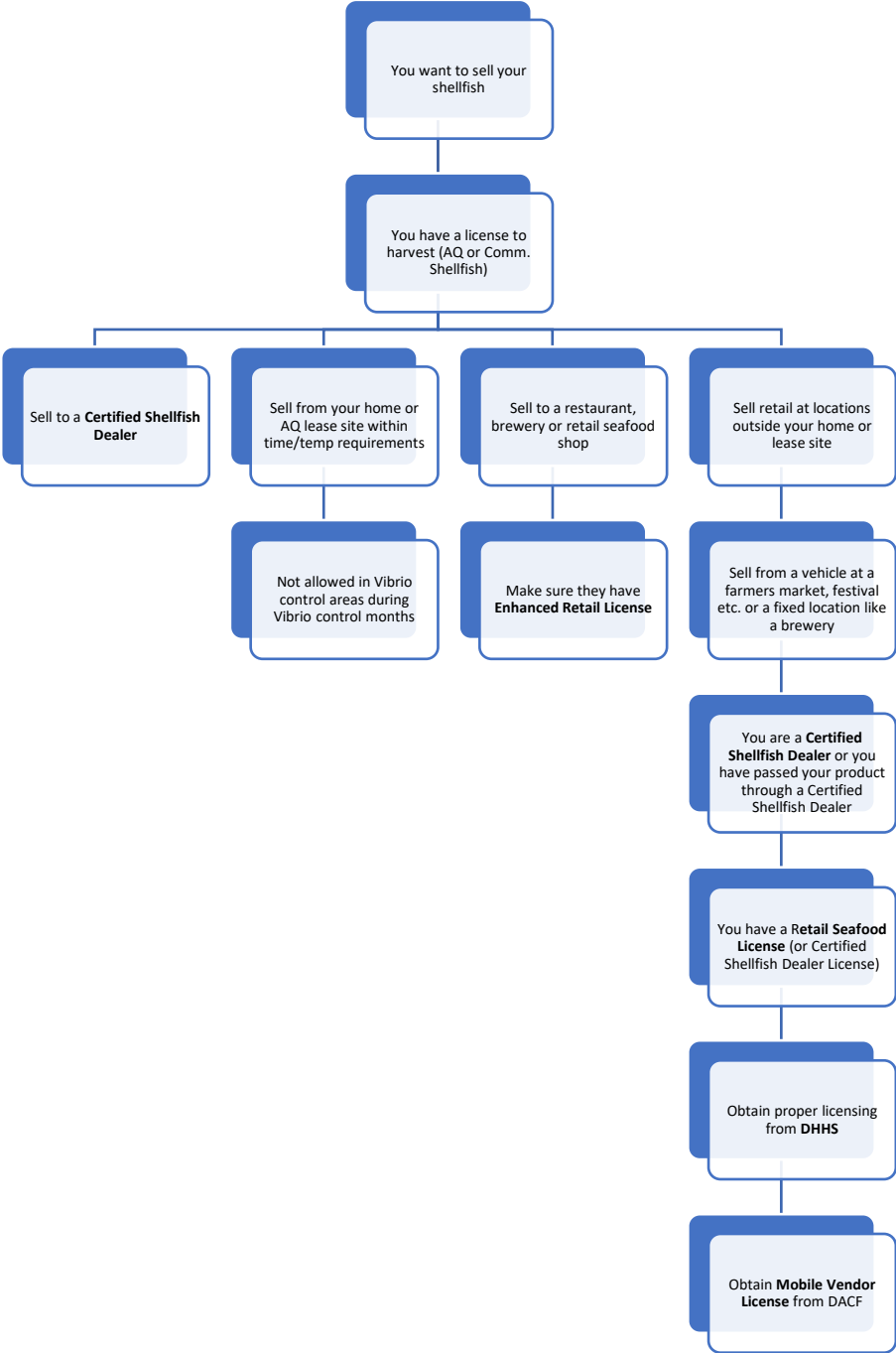


OUTSIDE OF MAINE

You want to sell your shellfish

You have a license to harvest (AQ or Comm. Shellfish)

Sell to a **Certified Shellfish Dealer**

Sell from your home or AQ lease site within time/temp requirements

Sell to a restaurant, brewery or retail seafood shop

Sell retail at locations outside your home or lease site

Not allowed in Vibrio control areas during Vibrio control months

Make sure they have **Enhanced Retail License**

Sell from a vehicle at a farmers market, festival etc. or a fixed location like a brewery

You are a **Certified Shellfish Dealer** or you have passed your product through a Certified Shellfish Dealer

You have a **Retail Seafood License** (or Certified Shellfish Dealer License)

Obtain proper licensing from **DHHS**

Obtain **Mobile Vendor License** from DACF
