Describe the type and amount of aquaculture to be conducted during the new lease term:

We would look to continue the same operations on this site. Oysters are bottom planted in the fall and then dragged up throughout the year. We also have floating seed bags on site that can be put on the site as early as May and removed by November.

2. Describe the amount of aquaculture conducted on the lease site during the previous lease term, including but not limited to seeding, cultivation or harvest of organisms:

We seeded the site every year. We also dragged on it every year. We are on site daily from March to December. We have also had seed bags on site every year. Our Hog island leases are critical to our company's survival. They are the main source of our inventory and where most of our 15 person team spends their days.

3. Suspended culture gear can attract birds that roost on the gear and defecate, potentially creating a pollution source impacting shellfish held within gear. We have only used the floating bags for seed on the site, if we use the bags for markets we will make sure to monitor them closely and attach physical deterrents (4') cable ties to the bags. We also hold all our product in wet storage for a week before it is sold.
