

SPOTTED TURTLE GOAL AND OBJECTIVES

1991 – 2001

*Adopted by MDIFW Commissioner and Advisory Council
June 25, 1993*

GOAL

Maintain a self-sustaining population of spotted turtles in Maine.

Information Objective: Estimate population distribution and abundance, population trend, population dynamics, self-sustaining population, limiting factors, habitat requirements, available habitat, and amount and type of protection provided spotted turtle habitat in Maine by the year 1996.

Population Objective: Increase the population of spotted turtles to the self-sustaining population level by the year 2000 (if not already at that level).

Habitat Objective: Conserve the quantity and quality of habitat necessary to support the self-sustaining population of spotted turtles by the year 2000.
