* General Duty citation would include hazards such as:

Fire Departments: no inspection of fire ladders, fire hose, firefighting turnout gear, and no training commensurate with duties.

Law Enforcement: No training commensurate with duties

Public Works Department, Sewer, Water, Sanitary Districts, and Transfer Recycling Facilities:
 No inspection of vehicle lifts, jack stands, and emergency stop devices training commensurate with duties, and high-visibility safety apparel while exposed to traffic.

Educational Facilities: No inspection of vehicle lifts, jack stands, and emergency stop devices.
